WHAT IS HOME HEALTH CARE?

Home health care provides skilled nursing care as well as other skilled care services like physical and occupational therapy, medical and social services. These services are given by a variety of skilled health care professionals at home. The home health care staff provides and helps coordinate the care and/or therapy your doctor orders. Along with the doctor, home health staff creates a written plan of care. It tells what services you will get to reach and keep your best physical, mental and social well-being.

WHY HOME HEALTH CARE?

As an alternative to in-hospital or nursing home care, home health allows for medical intervention to recovering disabled and chronically ill persons performed in the patient's home, promoting quicker recovery and independence.

WHEN IS HOME HEALTH CARE APPROPRIATE?

- Following a hospital stay for an illness or injury that does not require hospitalization.
- To care for an elderly member While recovering from accidents, heart attacks and strokes
- Wound care management
- Diabetes management

HOW DO YOU GET BRIGHT HOME HEALTH CARE?

Bright Home Health care is provided under the direct supervision of the patient's physician. To receive home health care, a physician must prescribe the care for the patient.

WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE AT BRIGHT HOME HEALTH CARE?

- Skilled Nursing Care:
including Ostomy care, catheter care, wound/ wound VAC care, pain management, diabetic teaching and monitoring.
- Physical Therapy:
including exercise to regain movement and strength in a bodyarea and training on how to use specials equipment or do daily activities like how to get in and out of a wheelchair or bathtub.
- A speech-Language Therapy (Pathology services):
including exercise to regain and strengthen speech skills.
- Occupational Therapy:
To help you be able to do usual daily activities by yourself.
- Home Health Aide:
Certified in nursing assistance, assist patients with the activities of daily living and personal care like bathing, grooming and light house keeping.

● Medical Social Services:

To help you with social and emotional concerns related to your illness. This might include counseling or help in finding resources in your community.

● Medication Teaching and Assistance

● Post Surgical Care
